The Food Bank of Waterloo Region

The Food Bank of Waterloo Region provides food to those in need through various programs, including:

- Emergency hampers
- Community centres and outreach
- Community meals
- Shelters and residential
- Other community programs

Some sobering statistics:

- 37% of those who access emergency food are children
- Of the households that access emergency food assistance 32% are single parent families and 14% are two parent families. Other households accessing food assistance are couples without children (15%) and single individuals (25%)
- 19% of those who rely on emergency assistance are the working poor, including those who are working full-time, part-time or are receiving employment insurance. Others acquire their primary income from Ontario Works (38%), Ontario Disability Support (24%), Pension (6%), Student Loans (1%), Disability (1%), while 7% have no income and 4% of participant's income is unknown
- 80,892 hampers were distributed to 62,952 households in 2013

The Food Bank website states that \$20 will provide a family with a food hamper with enough food for 4 dinners. \$100 will provide 300 meals and \$500 will provide 1500 meals within the community.



The Ronald McDonald House

Ronald McDonald House Charities Canada helps give sick children what they need most – their families. When a serious illness or injury strikes, the Ronald McDonald House provides a place for family members to stay while their child is in hospital.

Ronald McDonald Houses provide a home away from home for the families of seriously ill children who are staying at a nearby hospital. Some of the Ronald McDonald Houses also operate a Ronald McDonald Family Room within the walls of partnering hospitals. These are spaces that allow for peace and calm away from the beeps and pressures of the hospital, while still letting parents be just steps away from their child.

A few facts:

- There are 9 Ronald McDonald Family Rooms in hospitals across the country: in Winnipeg, London, Hamilton, Mississauga, Markham, Ottawa, Halifax and Moncton
- There are 14 Ronald McDonald Houses in Canada, providing more than 10,000 families a home away from home each year
- Due to limited space, some Houses turn away up to 70% of the families who ask to stay
- Ronald McDonald House Hamilton has 40 bedrooms and helps 700+ families per year
- Ronald McDonald House of Southwestern Ontario (London) has 34 bedrooms
- Ronald McDonald House Toronto has 81 bedrooms and helps 759 families per year
